Mozart's full name was Johannes Chrysostomus Wolfgangus Theophillus Amadeus Gottlieb Sigismundus Mozart.

Theophillus, Amadeus, Gottlieb, and Sigismundus all meant the same thing, just in different languages. They mean "Beloved of God." His family called him Wolferl.

Mozart began composing and performing music at the age of six.

Evgenia was the 2010 Scholarship Competition winner and will present a recital showcasing techniques, skill enhancements and performance learning's she gained from the prestigious Mozarteum in Salzburg, Austria. Evgenia will be accompanied by Sharon Berenson who is a professional pianist as well as being in her  $36^{\rm th}$  season as a violinist in the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra.

Following a choice of 60 master classes during two-week courses (three sessions) at the Morzarteum, in Salzburg, Evgenia sent a letter to our 2010 president, Kevin Pritchett:

I want to express my utmost gratitude to the Pro-Mozart Society for making it possible for me to attend the master classes at the Summer Academy Mozarteum in Salzburg! It was great!
