Facts about Mozart:

Mozart's first musical composition

Mozart, widely regarded as a genius, only took roughly thirty minutes to learn his first musical composition which he played on January 24th 1861. He was not even five years old yet. As an adult, Mozart would compose music in his head during long, uncomfortable carriage rides and store it in his brain until he could write it down.

Many composers payed homage to Mozart by creating variations to many of his themes. Joseph Hayden wrote that "posterity will not see such a talent again in 100 years."
